Dr. Thanh-Dam Truong is Associate Professor in Women/Gender and Development Studies at the Institute of Social Studies. In the 1980s she was one of the first scholars to have provided an academic analysis of the problem of sex tourism in South East Asia from the perspective of international political economy. Her work has been translated into several languages (Dutch, Japanese, Indonesian and Spanish). She has published widely on subjects such as human development, gender research and international migration, human trafficking and organised crime, and the gender of transition. Her current work addresses the intersection between transnationalized human security, development ethics and the ethics of care. She is the chief co-editor of the journal *Gender, Technology and Development*, and a member of the editorial advisory board of the *International and Interdisciplinary Journal Women, Social Justice and Human Rights*. Since 2004 she coordinates the European Focal Point for the Chubu University Open Research Centre Project 'Human Security in the Global Cities Networks'.
